Tricky Word Games to play at home



Snap

Each person will have a set of tricky words and put them in a pile face down. When you turn over a card that matches a card on another player's pile, you must be the first to say, "snap" The person who wins the most cards will win the game.

Pairs

Print the tricky words out twice and lay them face down. Pick up two cards at a time, if they are not the same pair you return them to the same place. The winner is the person gets the most pairs.






Park the car

Lay the tricky words down on the floor like a car park, a grown-up calls out a tricky word, the child drives a toy car to that tricky word.

Splat

Write 6 tricky words in a grid or loose on the floor, give the child a splatter (lolly stick or something similar - they could even make this) The children to splat the word that has been said. You could also use the same idea to play bean bag toss.
